A page from an exercise book and a card from M & Mme Stassen-Jorssen with the following: 'Given by Raymond Garlick, whose son, Iestyn, would often practise his writing when visiting J.C.P., more than thirty years ago and J.C.P. would copy it. The pencil writing is by Iestyn, the ink one by J.C.P. The first word is 'crochan' (Welsh for cauldron).
